WINE STORY:

Omen Story: One Spring day in 2014, an Atlas Vineyard Management team member Instagrammed a photo of an abandoned monastery that sits atop one of the vineyards we manage. The photo was hauntingly beautiful. We thought it would make a great label, so we printed it out and taped it to a wine bottle. Office visitors loved the bottle and excitedly asked if that was our wine brand. After what seemed like hundreds of inquiries it was obvious that it was a SIGN! We needed to make our own wine, and so OMEN was born. Today, we still feature that original Instagram photo on our Sierra Foothills Red Blend bottle, and it has inspired an entire series of labels and wines that we are proud to offer as part of our OMEN line. Vineyard source: 25% Pinot Noir - Wooldridge Creek Vineyard in Applegate Valley, Rogue Valley AVA, Oregon 75% Pinot Noir - Rock'N'R Ranch in Rogue Valley AVA, Oregon Tasting Notes: Deep, complex aromatics are accented by dark cherry and a touch of cranberry. Barrel aging lends subtle smoky notes and hints of baking spices to the flavor. The mouth-feel is rich and concentrated from the low yields & warm climate of the Rogue Valley. The wine has great depth yet is very balanced and finishes with a delicate texture. Winemaking: - Night Harvesting - Crushed/De-stemmed - Cold Soaking (4 days) - Warm fermentation to extract color and tannins - Pump-over 2 times a day - Low Pressure Pressing - Aged in Oak for 8 months (15% new) - Cold Stabilization - Sterile Filter Ingredients: grapes, yeast, french oak barrels, free sulfites <20 ppm
