Aromas: Blueberries, cedar and spice Flavors: Dark chocolate, blackberries and caramel Profile: medium in body and show very soft tannins, it provides a silky-smooth texture that's integrated with the tannins and oak for a complex palate and long finish. Already quite approachable but has the acidity and tannins to age very nicely. Vintage: For RJV Wines, 2016 extends a run of exceptional years for Cabernet Sauvignon to five in a row. Our only regret is that there wasn't more fruit! Harvest was a roller-coaster ride as the year swung from hot to cold and hot again. While there weren't severe heat spikes, the periods of hot days followed by runs of cooler days meant that the fruit ripened in waves. The young wines are aromatically expressive, open-knit and inviting, with soft contours, generous dark fruit and plenty of promise.
