WINE STORY:

Fruit-forward, smooth and balanced, Singer Cellars wines are Bordeaux varietals and blends produced from Napa Valley grapes. Cellar notes We practice the old-world winemaking method of *bâtonnage*, or stirring the lees. This process enhances the wine's structure, gives it extra body, increases the aromatic complexity, and produces a velvety rich mouthfeel. Each wine ages for up to 20 months in French oak barrels. 40% is new, with the balance in used French oak barrels. Drinkable upon release, our wines benefit from additional cellar aging, which allows the wine's complexities to develop and reveal themselves. Tasting notes Blending grape varieties is a true art for boutique winemakers. Like the extremely successful 2013 vintage, the fantastic new release of the B-Sharp 2014 Red Table Wine by Barry Singer immediately captures attention with tantalizing aromas of fresh violets, red berries, blue fruits, vanillin, and savory spices. On the palate, the wine is tangy, bright and lively with lavish notes of ripe blueberry, cherry, raspberry, cranberry, mocha, and cinnamon. Overall, an extremely well-made wine—especially for the price. With food, pair this wine with young cheeses with fresh berries and nuts, charcuterie, gourmet pizza, pulled-pork sandwiches, burgers and barbecued ribs, stews, and roasted meats. Singer Cellars showcases Barry Singer's passion for classic Bordeaux varietal blends. In 2004 Barry pursued a lifelong dream and began making wine. Fast-forward to today, and Singer Cellars is garnering awards and recognition for its silky, accessible yet robust red wines. The San Francisco Chronicle Wine Competition just awarded three of its highest awards to these 2014 vintages: Merlot–Best of Class, Aria–Double Gold, and Rhapsody–Gold.
